Arnold Pope, 89 of St. Ignace passed away peacefully Thursday evening, November 11 at Cheboygan Hospice House in Cheboygan. Arnold worked for the McNamee Dry Cleaners before entering the military, and served during WWII. He and his wife, Gladys owned St. Ignace Cleaners for over 35 years. He was very proud of his time in service,
