Kenneth Jay Kobes, Jr., age 55, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away Wednesday morning, August 1, 2007 at Northern Michigan Hospital. Ken was born on October 17, 1951 in St. Louis, Missouri. He graduated from Battle Creek Central High School with the class of 1969. Later he received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Lake Superior State University. On October 5, 1974, he married Deb (Lawrence) at the First Baptist Church of Sault Ste. Marie. Ken worked as an accountant for the Sault Tribe Health Center. Ken was a member of the Sault Wesleyan Church. He had been a board member at the church for more then twenty years, serving as chairman of the board for about ten years.
