Kevin B. Miller, age 39, of Sault Ste. Marie, MI passed away early Monday morning, January 4, 2021, at his home from a rare and painful form of cancer.

Kevin was born on October 6, 1981, in Southfield, Michigan to Raymond and Phyllis (Lane) Miller. He was a graduate of Lincoln Consolidated High School in Ypsilanti Township with the class of 2000. Kevin served in the United States Army with the 82nd Airborne. He pursued his love of cooking and catering and became a chef. From an early age, he was a defenseman playing hockey but was forced to stop following an injury while serving in the army. He enjoyed sports, canoeing, fishing, being with his friends around bonfires, and watching the Detroit Red Wings and the Detroit Lions.
