Marion Peltier, 90 of Cheboygan passed away late Monday morning, June 16 at Evergreen Living Center in St. Ignace. She was born July 27, 1923 in Cheboygan to Albert and Bernice (Olesek) Majestic. She attended grammar school at St. Charles Catholic School in Cheboygan, and sang in the choir all through school; then graduating from Cheboygan High School in 1942. Music was her passion, and she sang in the St. Charles Church choir all her life. She wrote the music for her graduating class in 1942. At the extended care facility she was known for singing "You are My Sunshine" constantly. She was a life member of St. Charles Catholic Church; Jack Pine Saddle Club; Cheboygan Snowmobile Club; and she and her husband were avid campers, and loved to travel, both in their motorhome and later with their 5th wheel. They traveled the entire United States. She married George Peltier on November 30, 1946 at St. Charles Church in Cheboygan and he died November 12, 2003. She was a Supervisor for Plymouth Industries many years, retiring in the late 80's.
