



Lawrence "Mose" Campbell

November 14, 1920 - June 22, 2014

Lawrence Joseph "Mose" Campbell, age 93, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away on Sunday morning, June 22, 2014 at the Hospice of the EUP - Hospice House. Mose was born in Detroit, Michigan on November 14, 1920, the son of the late John Francis and Margaret (LaBrie) Campbell. He attended Sault High School and later served his country in the United States Coast Guard. He did his basic training in Texas and New Orleans before being sent to Africa, Italy, and England. Mose returned home on the Queen Mary and was stationed in the 9th Navel District - Chicago, Grand Maris, and his home port of Sault Ste. Marie. He received the American Area Campaign Ribbon, WWII Victory Medal, and the European Area Campaign Medal with two stars. On September 22, 1951, he married Wilhelmina "Billie" Kanzler in Ohio. Mose later worked for the Sault Ste. Marie Fire Department where he attained the rank of Captain. He was an avid lifetime sportsman, who especially enjoyed fishing and hunting. He also enjoyed traveling throughout the United States, Canada, and Mexico, as well as, playing and watching hockey. Mose was a member of the Elks Club, American Legion, VFW, and the NRA. He is survived by his wife: Wilhelmina "Billie" Cambell; one granddaughter, and a special nephew: Ron (Debbie) Peake of Sault Ste. Marie, MI. He was preceded in death by his parents and two sons: Robin Campbell (1999) and Leslie Robert Campbell (1947). A graveside service will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, June 28, 2014 at Oaklawn Chapel Gardens with military honors to follow. Memorials may be left to Hospice of the EUP - Hospice House.
