Joseph W. Zagar, 88 of St. Ignace died early Monday morning, September 30 at his home. He was born February 4, 1925 in Hazel Park. to Anton and Louise (Cox) Zagar. He graduated from high school and served in the US Navy during WWII, from August 11, 1943 to March 9, 1946. Joe carried mail for the St. Ignace Route, and worked for McGregor Oil for 52 years, many at the Shell Station on US 2. He was an active member of St. Ignatius Loyola Catholic Church; and the St. Ignace Fire Department.
