Lilith Mary Palo, age 95, of Rudyard, Michigan, died at the Ball Hospice House of the EUP in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, on October 9, 2022. She was born in St. Ignace, Michigan, on September 11, 1927, to Carl and Eva Isabell (Grondin) Melvin.

Lilith grew up in St. Ignace and graduated Salutatorian from LaSalle High School in 1945. She worked as a phone operator in Sault Ste. Marie, before attending college in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. She married the love of her life, Howard George Palo, on August 30, 1946, in Indiana. They returned to Rudyard to raise their four children. In 1965, Lilith began working as the secretary/bookkeeper in the administration office for Rudyard Area Schools. She enjoyed and had great respect for her co-workers and the Superintendents and Administrators she worked for and after twenty-two years, she retired from Rudyard Schools.
