She took pride in her family, and was a sports fan for her kids, grandkids and great grandkids. She is a member of the Sault Tribe Chippewa Indians. and the St. Mary's Catholic Church.. She was a Census taker one year, a job she detested. She was an avid Lions fan and would not go to any function if the Tigers were playing. She had a mind of her own, and she spoke it, but was loved by all who knew her She was a fighter and stoodup to those twice her size, and enjoyed every minute of it. She will be sorely missed.

She is survived by her family, Daughter, Alice and Tony Martis, Rexton; Sons;; Howard and Cheryl Hood, Caffey; William and Kim Hood, Newberry; Ellis and Carrie Hood in New York; and special friend, Cindy and Clinton Comstock, Florida; 14 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren. She is the last of the 5 Struble siblings.
