



## Linda Diane Horn

June 30, 1941 - September 15, 2023

Linda Diane (King) Horn, age 82, of Afton, Michigan, formerly of Mackinac Island, died on September 15, 2023, at home surrounded by family.

She was born June 30th, 1941, in Flint, Michigan as one of fifteen children and stepchildren to Raymond Haas King and Veldyne DeWenton Hansen. Linda lived and grew up in Grand Rapids, Michigan, and Connecticut and graduated from Stratford High School in Connecticut.

She met her future husband Ed Horn at home and eventually a roller skating date. Linda and Ed married on July 4th, 1959, on Mackinac Island, Michigan while Linda was eighteen years old and Ed was in the Navy. After Ed separated from the Navy they moved to the San Jose, California area and lived there for twenty years, moving back to Mackinac Island in 1979. Linda and Ed moved to Afton in 1999 to enjoy their retirement but stayed close to all their Island friends and family.

Linda was employed at the First National Bank as a bank teller from 1981 to 1999 and was a member of the Mackinac Island School Board, Mackinac Island Lioness Club, and St. Anne's Catholic Church.

Linda enjoyed reading, playing cards, cooking, crafting, and painting.

Linda is survived by her husband, Edward Horn; son Jim Horn, daughter Jennifer (Ron) Price, Seven grandchildren: Sam Horn, Abby Horn, Tony Horn, Austin (Krista) Sheler, Allissa (Fred) Parks, Samantha Price, and Kimberly (Tyler) Foster., as well as seven great-grandchildren.

Linda was preceded in death by her parents Raymond and Veldyne, stepfather George Stella who was a vaudeville entertainer for decades and played piano at the Island House Hotel on Mackinac Island for over a decade, brother, Raymond King, and multiple step siblings.
