Lorraine Mary (Lowetz) Frazier, age 83, of Naubinway, Michigan passed away July 5, 2022, surrounded by her family. Lorraine was born in Moran, Michigan on June 14, 1939 to Joseph and Louise (Lupenitz) Lowetz.

Lorraine grew up in Moran, Michigan with her nine siblings and graduated in 1957 from LaSalle High School in St. Ignace, Michigan.
