Marceline "Marcie" Yvonne (Gagnon) Waggoner, age 92, of Cedarville, Michigan, died on Monday, December 15, 2025, at her home, surrounded by her loving family. She was born on July 30, 1933, in Detroit, Michigan, to Clifford and Alice (DesJardin) Gagnon.

Marcie grew up in Cedarville and graduated from Cedarville High School with the Class of 1951. Marcie loved sewing and knitting and was especially known for the beautiful baby blankets she lovingly made for each of her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She treasured time spent with her family, and her kitchen table

was a place of comfort and gathering where stories were shared, laughter was abundant, and everyone felt welcome. She always had a warm cup of the best coffee waiting and cookies in her cookie jar. She also enjoyed cooking for family and friends, bird watching, and flowers.
