



## Floyd A. Paquin

Floyd A. Paquin Sr. 74 of St. Ignace passed away Saturday, December 7 at McClaren Northern Michigan Hospital following a heart attack earlier in the day. He was born in St. Ignace on July 18, 1939 to Alex and Theresa (Carson) Paquin. He attended Ursuline Academy through the 8th grade and has been a commercial fisherman all his life. He formerly worked for Dick Hagen Fisheries, and was a construction worker for Tom Shaw Construction in Cheboygan. They built the Mackinac County Jail; buildings in Marquette and the Soo; and many others. He worked for Days Inn in Maintenance, also Straits Breeze Motel maintenance. He was a self-taught musician all his life, and could play most any instrument. He will be remembered for playing in bands called Solid Gold; Country Cutups and others. He is a former member of the Moose Lodge; and is an Elder Member of Sault Tribe Chippewa Indians.
