Martin Brant Stevenson, age 62, of St. Ignace, Michigan, died Saturday, January 13, 2018, at Hiland Cottage in Petoskey, Michigan. He was born September 25, 1955, in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan.

Martin grew up in Bluffton, Indiana. He graduated from Bluffton High School. He served in the Indiana Air National Guard in Fort Wayne, Indiana. For many years, as he served in the National Guard, he worked both as a factory worker and yard loader operator at a foundry where Swiss truck caps were manufactured. More recently he worked as a caretaker at Castle Rock Lakefront Campark in St. Ignace, and for Mackinac Island Carriage Tours on Mackinac Island.

Martin was an artist who truly enjoyed sketching and painting. He was a self-taught fiddle player who played for family and for his own enjoyment. He also enjoyed the outdoors. Martin loved his nieces and nephews.
