October 17, 1927 - January 20, 2016

Mary Lynn (Rutledge) Huyck, age 88, of Pickford, Michigan, died on January 20, 2016 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. She was born on October 17, 1927 to Leonard and Margaret Allie (Hill) Rutledge at their home in Blairville, Michigan.

Mary Lynn attended Blairville Country School and graduated from Pickford High School in 1945. She married Vern Huyck on January 2, 1946 at the Pickford Methodist Church. Together, they bought Vern's family farm and began farming for many years before Vern bought a truck and started his own trucking business. Mary Lynn continued to run the farm and they raised four children before selling the farm in 1968. They moved north of Pickford, where they ran Vern Huyck Trucking until retiring in 1980. During their retirement they spent 35 winters at their winter home, in Florida.

Mary Lynn was a member of the Pickford, Presbyterian Church.
