



## Maurice William Davis

April 22, 1940 - April 2, 2022

On April 2, 2022, Maurice William Davis died peacefully at War Memorial Hospital in Sault Sainte Marie, Michigan. He was 81. Maurice "Moe" is survived by his only daughter, Amy Davis; his grandson; and sister Dorothy Burrows; and brother James Davis. 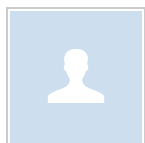
