Robert "Bob" Konle, 87 of Cut River Road, Epoufette, passed away early Thursday morning, August 20, at Evergreen Living Center in St. Ignace. He was born in Grand Rapids, MI, on November 9, 1927. His parents were George and Lola (Phillips) Konle. He graduated from LaSalle High School, and served in the U.S. Army from 1946 to 1948. Bob owned Konle's Standard Service in St. Ignace for over 40 years, which started as a Gulf Station on Ferry Lane during the operation of the State Ferry boats. He was a Professional Bowler for 2 years, and was a member of the PBA. He also loved to play golf. He was an avid deer hunter, and a marksman. Bob was the Hendricks Township Supervisor from 1984 to 2008, and also the assessor. He was a level 3 assessor, and also was assessor for Hulbert Township and Bay Mills Township. After his U.S. Army days, he worked for Alpine Construction in Road Construction. He was a member of the area Ambulance Committee for many years. After retirement from business, he and his wife sold firewood at the State Park for several years. Bob married Shirley Alexander on July 1, 1950, and she died June 22, 2013. They were married at St. Ignatius Loyola Catholic Church in St. Ignace.

He is survived by 2 daughters, Sandy (Roger) Cece, Brevort; Cathy (Charles) Campbell, Pickford; 8 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a son, Terry, in March 2010, and his parents.

Funeral service was Saturday, August 22, at 11:00 am at Dodson Funeral Home, with Fr. Norbert Landreville officiating. Visitation was from 10:00am until service time. Burial was in Epoufette Cemetery, with a dessert social following at Hendricks Township Fire Hall.
