Neoma "Nicki" Marguerite Krzykowski, age 86, of St. Ignace, Michigan, died at McLaren Northern Michigan Hospital in Petoskey, Michigan, on October 3, 2022, and is now in the arms of her late husband. She was born in Detroit, Michigan, on August 3, 1936, to Raymond L. and Marguerite (Smith) Almas.
