Nicholas M. Poliski, age 91, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away early Sunday morning, August 17, 2014 at the Hospice of the EUP - Hospice House. Nicholas was born on February 3, 1923 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, to the late Andrew and Mary (Kiszinowski) Poliski. He attended McKinley School up to the 8th grade. Nicholas served in the United States Coast Guard serving during WWII in the Pacific Campaign on the USS Alhena. He married Evelyn Huskey on September 12, 1945 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. He was a lifetime member of the VFW Post 3676 and the N.R.A. Nicholas loved hunting and fishing and spending time with his grandchildren. He also enjoyed watching the Detroit Red Wings. He was a carpenter in the Local Union 46 and later became the business agent. Nicholas was one of the first carpenters to work on the Mackinac Bridge, as well as one of the last upon it's completion.
