Patrick Eugene Garries, age 77, of St. Ignace, Michigan, died January 5, 2021, in Petoskey, Michigan. He was born October 13, 1943, in North Branch, Michigan, to Charles Eugene and Wilma Jean (Dewey) Garries.

Patrick grew up in St. Ignace, Michigan, riding the SS Chief Wawatam car ferry to school in Mackinac City part of that time. After graduating from high school in Mackinaw City, he worked at Winkleman's Shoe Store and then for Pemble's Grocery as a meat cutter.
