



## Paul Joseph Vigneaux

December 8, 1930 - May 31, 2016

Paul Joseph Vigneaux, age 85, of Rudyard, Michigan, died May 31, 2016, at home. He was born December 8, 1930, in Rudyard Township, to Edmund Joseph and Alice Marie (Tremblay) Vigneaux.

Paul grew up on the family farm west of Rudyard, then later, the family moved into town. He graduated from Rudyard High School in 1950. After graduation, Paul was drafted into the United States Army and served his Country in the Korean War, from 1951 to 1953. Upon his return from Korea, Paul worked for Bud wheel factory in Detroit for a short time. He returned to Rudyard and married Betty Ann Leveille on October 13, 1962, in St. Ignace, Michigan. They settled in Rudyard where they raised their three children. For most of his working years, Paul worked construction during the summers and snow removal at Kincheloe Air Force Base during the winters.

Paul was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Parish in Rudyard. He had a great appreciation and conviction for his faith and raised his children to love their faith as well. He was a life member of the VFW Post #4905 where he was past Commander.

Paul always loved to hunt and he enjoyed gardening.

Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, Connie (Darwin) Stahl of Dafter, Michigan, and Michael (Lucynda) Vigneaux of Sault Ste.
