Pauline Mae Dugan, age 88, of Cedarville, Michigan, died January 11, 2016, at Cedar Cove in Cedarville, Michigan. She was born on September 3, 1927, to Clarence and Catherine (Dornbecker) Charron in Trenton, Michigan.

Pauline grew up in Trenton and graduated from Trenton High School. She earned a Masters Degree in Education from Eastern Michigan University. Pauline worked for the Wyandotte School District for several years until she married Ralph Dugan on November 8, 1952 at St Joseph Catholic Church in Trenton. They made their home in New Boston, Michigan, where she worked for the Huron Public Schools. Pauline and Ralph took over Dugan and Sons Lumber Yard from Ralph's parents. Ralph died in 1988. Pauline later worked at a children's clothing store. Seven years ago, Pauline moved to Hessel to live with her daughter and son-in-law.

Pauline enjoyed many activities including flower gardening, and belonging to a garden club, reading, and playing the violin. She belonged to Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Grosse Ile, and St. Stephens Catholic Church in New Boston. She served as lector for a time at both.
