Randall H. "Randy" Proffitt, age 68, of Brimley, Michigan passed away Monday afternoon, November 10, 2014 at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, Michigan. Randy was born in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan on June 21, 1946. He graduated from Sault High School with the class of 1964 and later attended LSSU. Randy worked as a switching equipment technician for Michigan Bell Telephone Company.
