



## R. Scott Shawan

February 16, 1956 - July 18, 2014

R. Scott Shawan, age 58, of Drummond Island, Michigan, died Friday, July 18, 2014 at Ball Hospice House in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. Scott was born February 16, 1956 in Columbus, Ohio, to Jacob Albright Shawan and Margery Ann (Milroy) Shawan.

Scott grew up in Columbus and at age 17, moved to Texas with his sister Cindy and settled in Austin. He joined the United States Navy and served on the aircraft carrier the U.S. Carl Vinson. His duties included guiding aircraft takeoffs and landings, and as a ship navigator.

Scott was a member of the Lighthouse Christian Church on Drummond Island. He enjoyed astronomy, flying kites, cooking, fishing, photography, gardening, and collecting antiques. Since turning 29, Scott always celebrated the yearly anniversary of his 29th birthday rather than adding a year to his age.

Scott is survived by his wife, Diana Webster-Shawan of Drummond; son, Jacob Scott Shawan of Manzanita, Oregon; daughter, Katie Marie Shawan at home; sister, Cynthia Choate of Laguna Park, Texas; and brother, Jacob A. "Chip" and wife Cheri Shawan of Groveport, Ohio.

Scott was preceded in death by his parents and by his brother-in-law, Billy G. Choate.

A funeral service will be held Saturday, July 26, at 3:00 P.M. at the Lighthouse Christian Church, 29898 E. Pine Street on Drummond Island with Pastor Scott Danforth conducting the service.

Burial was in Drummond Island Cemetery.
