January 23, 1940 - May 9, 2022

Robert “Bob” James Beaudry, age 82, died at home in Kinross, Michigan, on May 9, 2022. He was born on January 23, 1940, in Manistique, Michigan to Ovela and Doris Loraine (Macabee) Beaudry.

Bob grew up in Kinross and moved to Ypsilanti, Michigan, in his teens. He worked for the Saline Reporter, and Ann Arbor News, as a machinist for twelve years. He met Mary Blackwell and they married on November 14, 1959, in Ypsilanti. They drove taxicab for several years. In 1974, they moved to Kinross and operated B & D County Market until 1982, and then worked for Forest Supply. They moved back to Ypsilanti and Bob worked at Eastern Michigan University as a maintenance tech for seventeen years. He retired in 2005 and they returned to Kinross.

Bob was a member of the Lion’s Club in Kinross.

Bob loved nature and enjoyed to deer hunt, working in his yard-enjoying a “cold drink”, bird watching, and watching the freighters pass through the canal in Sault Ste Marie, Michigan.
