



## Robert Gerald Catterfeld

August 4, 1926 - May 30, 2007

Robert Gerald Catterfeld, age 80, of Saginaw, Michigan passed away early Wednesday morning, May 30, 2007 at his cottage in Barbeau, Michigan. Robert was born in Saginaw, Michigan on August 4, 1926, the son of the late Julius and Edith (Zimmerman) Catterfeld. He graduated from Vassar High School with the class of 1945. Robert served his country in the United States Navy in WWII. He served on the LST 945 Beach Comber as a gunner in the South Pacific. Robert was a contractor, and former owner of the Warwick Lounge in Saginaw Michigan. Aside from his entrepreneurship he was the creator of the Bull Master, bullhead cleaning tool. He enjoyed his family, fishing, hunting and making crafts. Robert was also one of the founding fathers of St. Barnabas Lutheran Church in Sault Ste. Marie, MI. Robert is survived by his wife of 58 years; Jean (Pugh) Catterfeld, whom he married on July 3, 1948.
