Robert L. "Bob" States, age 84 of Barbeau, Michigan, passed away on Tuesday, June 28, 2016 at his home. He was born on September 13, 1931 at the Blake family farm near Oldenburg, Indiana, the son of the late Herman and Ora (Blake) States. On February 28, 1970, Bob married his wife of over 46 years, Carolyn Ann Achor, in Dayton, Ohio.
