Robert John Van Horn, age 89, of Cedarville, Michigan, died on February 21, 2014 at Cedar Cove Assisted Living Community in Cedarville. He was born on February 24, 1924 in Pontiac, Michigan to Frank and Gertrude (Fox) Van Horn.

Bob was born and raised in Pontiac. After graduating from High School, he joined straight in to the United States Army where he was a sharp shooter stationed in Italy. When he returned from WWII, he and his brothers started VanHorn Concrete providing ready mix concrete in Auburn Hills and Waterford, Michigan. Bob married Ann Comps on February 17, 1963. They lived in Lake Orion until 1972 when they retired and moved to Cedarville. Beginning in 1981, Bob and Ann owned and operated The Channel Marker Restaurant until 1986 when they retired again.

Bob was a member of Our Lady of the Snows Catholic Church in Hessel.

Bob liked to make clocks and was known as the “clockmaker”. He made and gave away over 1000 clocks in his retirement years. Bob loved to golf and he had a hole in one at the St. Ignace Golf Course.

Bob is survived by many nieces, nephews, and dear friends.

Bob was preceded in death by his wife, Ann; brothers, Francis, Donald, and Cyril Van Horn; and sisters, Margaret Garrison and Florence Legge.
