Rodney Clifford Carr, age 68, of Rudyard, Michigan, died October 5, 2018, at home with his family at his side. He was born January 16, 1950, in Rudyard.

Rod was a lifelong Rudyard resident who graduated from Rudyard High School in 1968. He served in the United States Army in Vietnam. Rod worked as a diesel mechanic and an agricultural specialist. He enjoyed horses and doing farrier work. He did farrier work and drove taxi's for the Grand Hotel on Mackinac Island. He was an extra in the movie, Somewhere In Time, that was filmed on the island.

Rod is survived by two daughters, Kasie Carr and Katie Carr; one granddaughter, Kaylynn Carr; his mother, Arbutus "Boots" (Kemp) Carr, all of Rudyard; and one sister, Maryann Engle of Elkhart, Indiana.

Rod was preceded in death by his father, Clifford Herman Carr on May 20, 2018.

A private entombment with military honors is planned.
