Conrad P. Becker Jr. 81 of St. Ignace passed away Monday evening, November 3 at McLaren Northern Michigan Hospital in Petoskey following a lingering illness. He was born in Allenville on May 3, 1933 to Conrad P. and Louise (Duchette) Becker Sr. He was one of 12 children born to the Becker family and the last survivor. Connie was an institution in St. Ignace; heading the DPW for 51 years. He served in the U.S. Army for 2 years during the Korean War, after he was drafted and served at White Sands, N.M. missile site. He then came back to resume his duties with the City. If there was a flake of snow, you could see him traveling the streets checking for slippery spots. no matter what time of day or night. He loved to go to camp at Black River, in fact it was his second home. He loved to hunt and fish. He was not a joiner of clubs, but every one knew Connie Becker where ever you went. He was a member of St. Ignatius Loyola Catholic Church.

He is survived by his family; Conrad Becker III; Christopher Becker; Charles (Tina) Becker; Steve (Becky) Becker, all St. Ignace; Pam (David) Stowe and Susan (Dave) Lumas both Traverse City; and 13 grandchildren. He was preceded in death by brothers, Eldred, Clifford, Chester, Chuck and Norman, and sisters, Esther and Electa, and children who died as infants.
