Rose Emeline Griffin, age 83, of Cedarville, Michigan, died January 11, 2019, at home. She was born November 4, 1935, in Cedarville, to Claude and Melissa (Izzard) Haynes.

Rose grew up in Cedarville attending Cedarville schools. At the age of 12 years old, after school she worked for Smith's Restaurant. As an adult, she worked at the Bon Aire and Lil's Snack Bar in Cedarville. On September 24, 1966, Rose married Jerry F. Griffin and they continued to make their home in Cedarville. They operated Griffin's Garage. They loved to fish together and often put a "Gone Fishing" sign on the door and went fishing. They retired in the 1980's. In retirement, they loved to fish, hunt, and travel. They wintered on South Padre Island in Texas for many years. Jerry died on February 19, 2004.

Rose loved to spend time with her children and grandchildren. She loved to feed the deer, birds, and anyone who walked in her door. Rose was a member of the Clark Township Ambulance Corp and also served as its Secretary/Treasurer. She was a member of the Law White VFW Ladies' Auxiliary. After her husband's stroke, she cared for him at home and in 2001, she received the Marquette General Home Health & Hospice caregiver award.
