



## Sandra G. Izzard

April 30, 1945 - July 16, 2014

Sandra Gayle Izzard, age 69, of Cedarville, Michigan, died Wednesday, July 16, 2014 at Munson Medical Center in Traverse City, Michigan, with her family at her side. She was born April 30, 1945 in Stalwart, Michigan, to Samie Warren and Anna (Marowski) Stevenson.

Sandi grew up in Stalwart where she attended a small one room school house for the young grades and then completed grade school at Raber Township Schools.
