Shellsea Blair "Shelly" Lefebre, age 12, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away unexpectedly Sunday morning, September 21, 2014 on Drummond Island, Michigan. Shelly was born on December 15, 2001 in Coos Bay, Oregon. She was a seventh grader at Sault Area Middle School. She was a member of 4-H, Girl Scouts Troop #5160, and Calvary Baptist Church - where she attended AWANA. She enjoyed sports, including basketball, volleyball, hunting, fishing, camping, and being outdoors. She was the manager of her volleyball team. Shelly was also very artistic, with some of her art even being sent to Japan. She was a crafty girl, who enjoyed sewing, quilting, cooking, and baking. She was also very goal oriented. She was determined to get her pilot's license prior to getting her driver's license. She loved to fly. Shelly is survived by her parents: José and Michelle (Schiel) Lefebre of Sault Ste. Marie, MI; three sisters: Juseliz Lefebre of Hollywood, FL, Joy Lefebre and Malia Lefebre both of Sault Ste. Marie, MI, and her grandparents: Arthur and Joy Schiel of Sault Ste. Marie, MI.
