Mr. Shirley "Dean" Lever, age 93, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away Tuesday morning, October 8, 2019, in Charleston, SC.

Dean was born in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan on December 27, 1925, the son of the late James and Hazel (Sterns) Lever. After graduation from Sault High School, he went to Northern Michigan University earning his degree in business administration.
