Stanley Albert Bickham, age 90, of St. Ignace, Michigan, died at Cedar Cove Assisted Living in Cedarville, Michigan, on November 9, 2022. He was born in Hessel, Michigan, on April 9, 1932, to Peter and Delia Augusta (Lindberg) Bickham.
