



Stanley Russell Fredrickson

November 30, 1939 - August 17, 2014

Stanley Russell Fredrickson, age 74, of Brimley, Michigan passed away early Sunday morning, August 17, 2014 at War Memorial Hospital. Stan was born on November 30, 1939 in Peru, Iowa, the son of the late Russell and Faye (Stottlemeyer) Fredrickson. He grew up in Ames, Iowa and joined the U.S. Navy at a young age. In the Navy he was an engineer/boiler operator. Later he joined the U.S. Coast Guard, serving throughout the Vietnam War. His primary job in the Coast Guard and through his military retirement was that of a cook. Later Stan worked as a shift supervising cook at the Kinross Correctional Facility. He would continue working for Mr. B's and the Kewadin Casino. On October 21, 1961, Stan married Twyla Renshaw in Brimley, Michigan. He graduated from Sault High night school with the class of 1981, which was the same year that his son, Paul, graduated. Stan enjoyed gardening vegetables, cooking for church activities, watching bull riding, and listening to blue grass music. He loved to play a variety of games with his grandchildren and the rest of the family. Stan was a member of the Brimley Baptist Church. He is survived by his wife: Twyla Fredrickson; a daughter: Sharon (Mark) SanAngelo of Sault Ste. Marie, MI; four grandchildren: Michael Beck, Brandon Beck, Hollyann Beck, and Tony SanAngelo. He is also survived by a sister: Pat Anderson; a sister-in-law: Pat Fredrickson; a step brother: Dale Zea; two step-sisters: Ruby Sferna and Ruth (William) Jenkins; and a nephew: Brian Fredrickson.
