Terence G. Kelly Terence G. "Terry" Kelly, age 69, of Brimley, Michigan passed away early Sunday morning, February 18, 2007 at his home. Terry was born in Detroit, Michigan on July 11, 1937 to the late George and Gladys (McGregor) Kelly. He graduated from Salesian High School in Detroit. Terry served his country in the United States Navy as a sonar technician in the South Pacific. He went on to work in management in credit unions and banking. Following retirement, he and his wife Joyce retired to Bay Mills. He was a lover of history, reading, hockey, crossword puzzles, and sudoku. He had a wonderful sense of humor and he knew every back road in the State of Michigan. Terry was a life member of the Knights of Columbus. He was also a member of the Clan Gregor Society and the Bay Mills / Brimley Historical Society. Terry is survived by his wife Joyce (Engelman) Kelly, whom he married on October 10, 1964 at the Gesu Church in Detroit. He is also survived by four children; Kevin (Vicki) Kelly of Detroit, MI, Maureen Kelly of Jacksonville, FL, Dan (Carrie) Kelly of Farmington Hills, MI, and Kathleen Kelly of Detroit, MI, six grandchildren; Kim, Matt, Katelyn, Kendall, Olivia, and Marcus, and a sister; Mary Jane Kelly of Modesto, CA. Terry was also a "special dad" to Sarah Corbitt, a "special grandpa" to Troy Stewart, and a "special brother" and friend to many. Visitation will be held from 5:00 until 8:00 PM on Monday, February 19, 2007 at C.S. Mulder Funeral Home with a Rosary service at 7:00PM.
