Timothy Lee Grisdale, age 76, of DeTour Village, Michigan, died December 24, 2018, at home. He was born October 24, 1942, in Mt. Pleasant, Michigan, to Leo Francis Grisdale and Ann Marie (Breuer) Grisdale.

Tim attended Sacred Heart Academy in Mt. Pleasant and shortly after graduating moved to Lakeland, Florida, to be a pitcher for the Detroit Tigers minor baseball league.
