Tracy Alan Bartlett, age 59, of Naubinway, Michigan, died on June 11, 2022, at home. He was born June 19, 1962, in Reed City, Michigan.

Tracy grew up in the White Cloud area of Michigan and lived much of his adult life there. He joined his family in the Rexton area of Michigan, for a few years working with his stepdad in the logging industry and then returned to the White Cloud area, where he worked for a tree trimming services and various other jobs.
