Edward J. Martin, 82 of St. Ignace passed away early Monday morning October 14 at Evergreen Living Center following a lingering illness. He was born in Gros Cap; Martin Lake Road on February 15, 1931 to John B. and Mary Jane (Robinson) Martin; one of 16 children born to the Martin family. He is the last survivor. He entered the U.S. Marine Corp in 1953 and served 2 years, and was discharged on April 17, 1955. He worked as a Commercial Fisherman after being discharged, and then worked for McGregor Oil Co, for over 40 years, mostly as a delivery truck driver, and then maintenance. He is an Elder with the Sault Tribe Chippewa Indians, and a member of St. Ignatius Loyola Catholic Church.

He is survived by a son, Edward Jr. (Ann) Martin, Belle Center, Ohio; a daughter, Lindean (George) Shooster, St. Ignace; grandchildren; Lee (Luke) Tucker; Brooks Martin (Mell Snyder); Charlotte (Andy) Hanna; and 5 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, Charlotte on July 17, 1998; siblings; Francis, Melvin; John Jr; Clyde; Leonard; Belle; Elizabeth; Josephine; Louise; and several siblings that died at birth.

A Memorial Mass will be Friday, October 18 at 11 am at St. Ignatius Church with Fr. Norbert Landreville and Fr. Pawel Mecwel officiating. Burial will be in Gros Cap Cemetery. Dodson Funeral Home assisted with arrangements.
