Victor Andrew "Chum" Hillock, Jr., age 82, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away Sunday, May 19, 2019, at McLaren Northern Michigan Hospital.

Chum was born on May 20, 1936, in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan to the late Victor and Edith (Fegan) Hillock, Sr. He graduated from Sault High School with the class of 1955 and went on to earn an Agricultural Certificate from the Michigan State University of Agriculture and Applied Science. On October 5, 1963, Chum married Lois Jean Lines at the First United Presbyterian Church in Sault Ste. Marie.

Chum was a member of the Belgian Draft Horse Corporation of America, Holstein Association USA, Farm Bureau, and the First United Presbyterian Church. He was a dairy farmer and a licensed livestock dealer that could be found every Wednesday at Northern Michigan Livestock. Chum enjoyed all aspects of farming, loved raising and showing his Belgian draft horses and anything that would promote children, like 4H and youth livestock activities. His true love was people and his greatest joy was visiting and telling stories with neighbors and friends.
