Vivienne Patricia Lorraine (Gilhooly) Carmichael, age 91, of Drummond Island, Michigan, died May 15, 2022, at McLaren Northern Michigan Hospital, under hospice care, in Petoskey, Michigan. She was born in Wayne County, Michigan, on December 23, 1930, to Stanley Percy and Edna Pearl (Downey) Gilhooly.

Vivienne grew up around Warren, Michigan, and graduated from Lincoln High School. She met Donald Carmichael and they married on September 16, 1950. 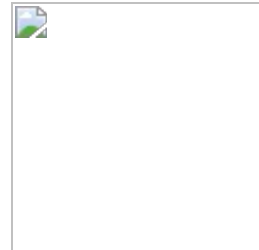
