Leo W. Fischer, 80 of Trout Lake passed away Monday afternoon, January 23 at Evergreen Living Center in St. Ignace following a lingering illness. He was born on August 7, 1931 in Kennon, WI.. His parents were Joseph and Freida (Frazick) Fischer. The family came to Trout Lake when he was 8 years old, and he lived there since , except during the Korean War when he served as a Tank Driver in the US Army.
